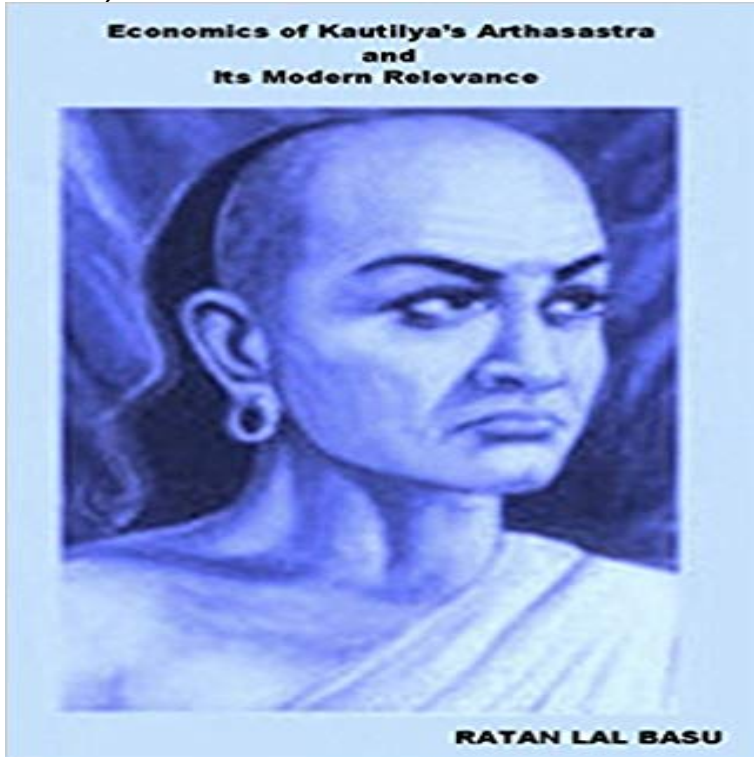


# Economics of Chanakyas Arthasastra and Its Modern Relevance ( 300 B.C.): Ancient Economics
