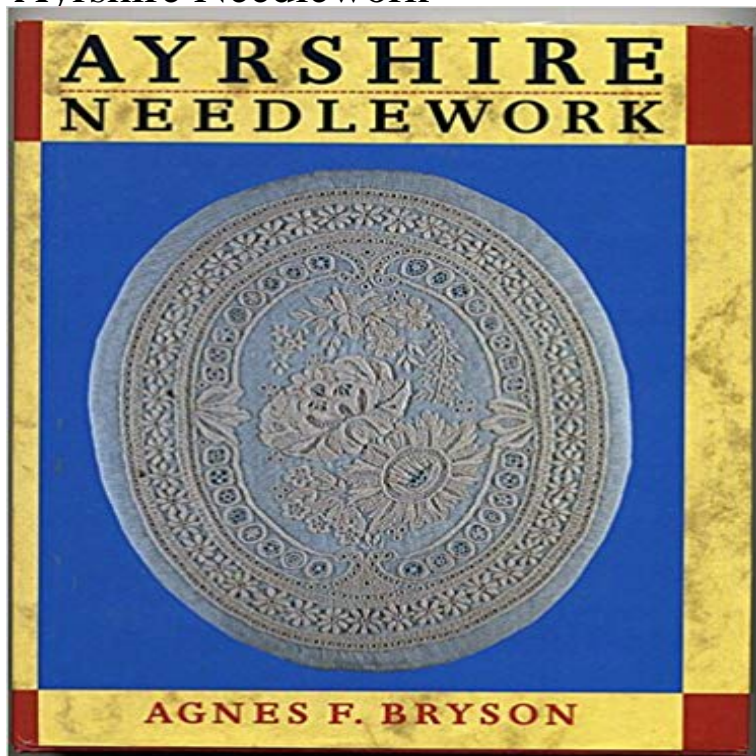


## Ayrshire Needlework
