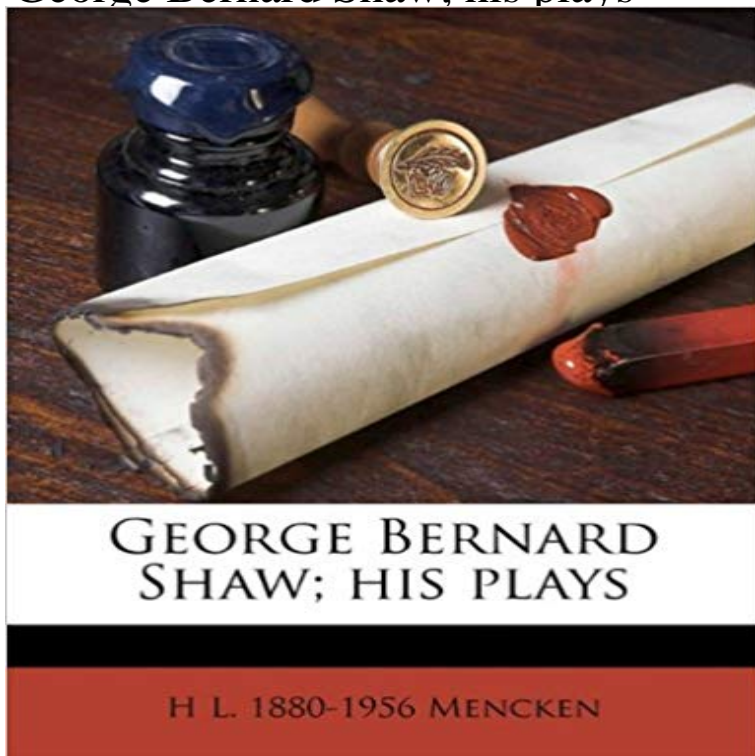


George Bernard Shaw; his plays
