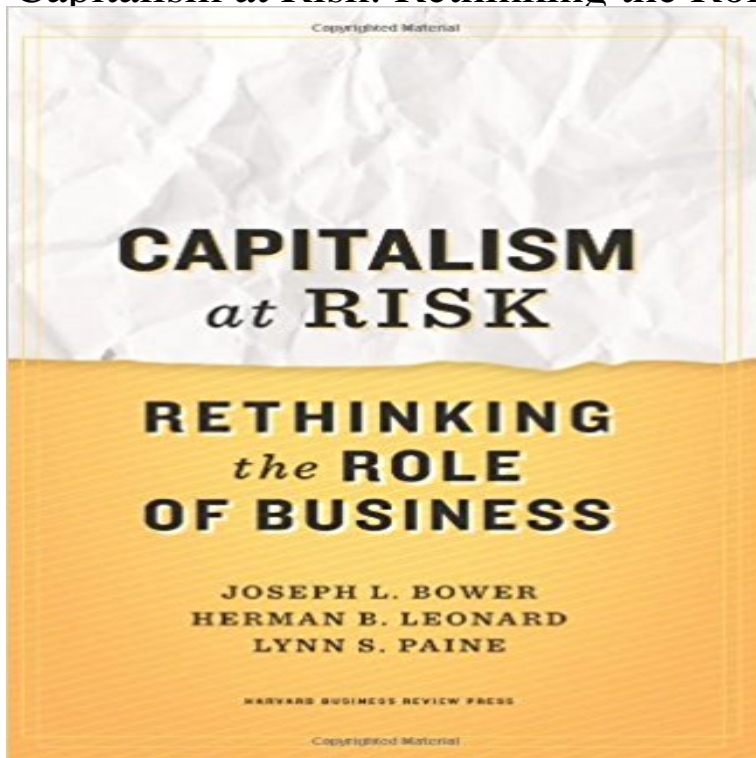


Capitalism at Risk: Rethinking the Role of Business
