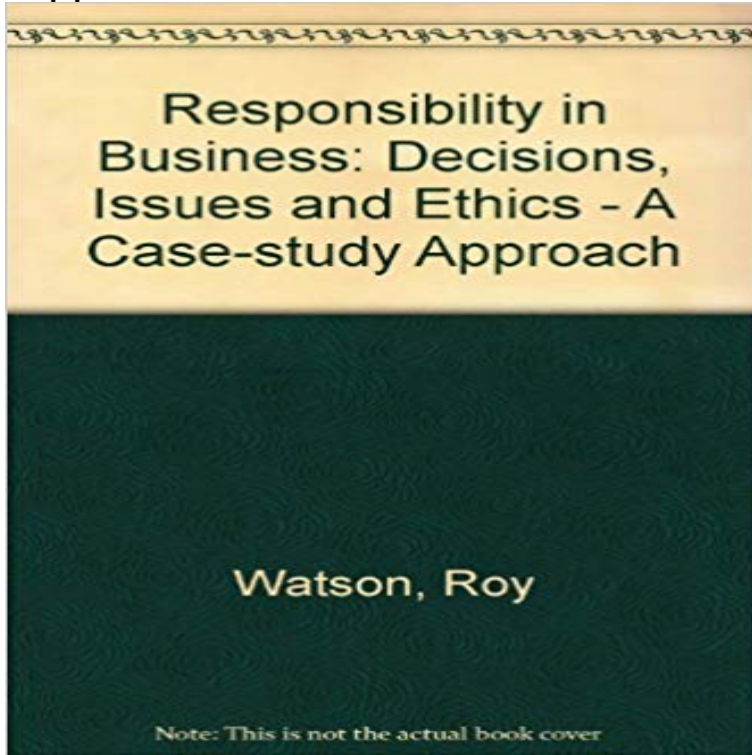


Responsibility in Business: Decisions, Issues and Ethics - A Case-study Approach

Two real companies are also examined in depth. This book is designed for students on any business related course for 16-19 year-olds and is especially relevant to the BTEC National core module People in Organisations.
