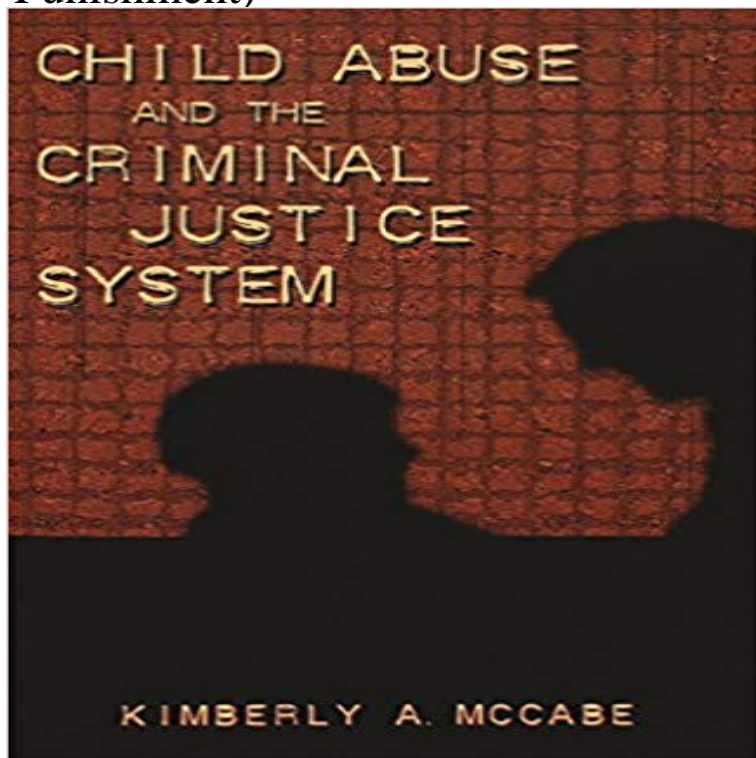


Child Abuse and the Criminal Justice System (Studies in Crime and Punishment)
