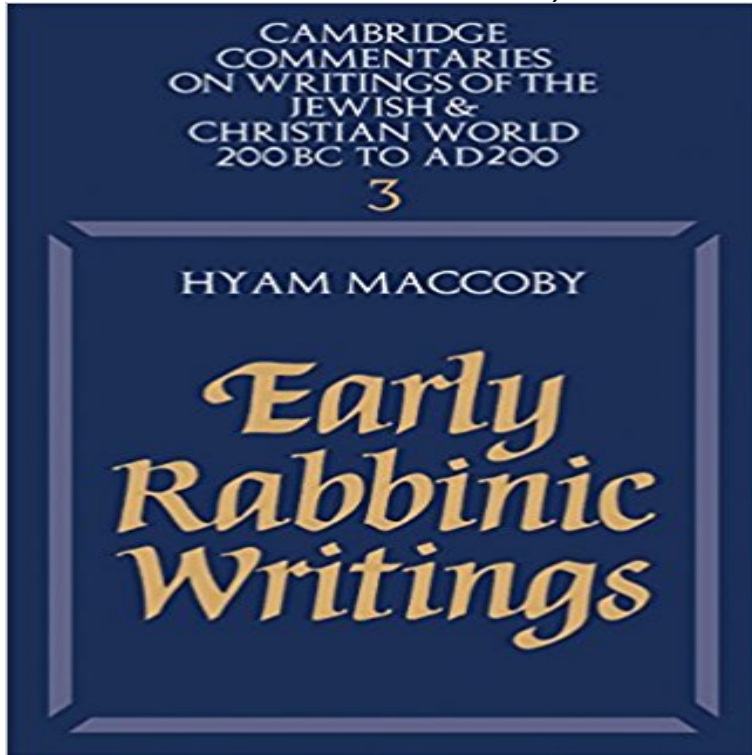


Early Rabbinic Writings (Cambridge Commentaries on Writings of the Jewish and Christian World)
