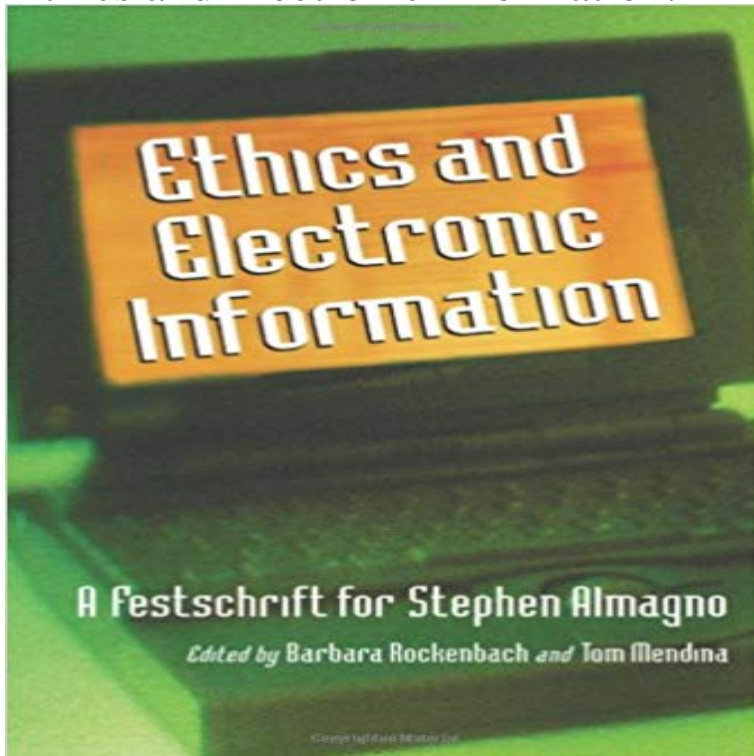


## Ethics and Electronic Information: A Festschrift for Stephen Almagno
