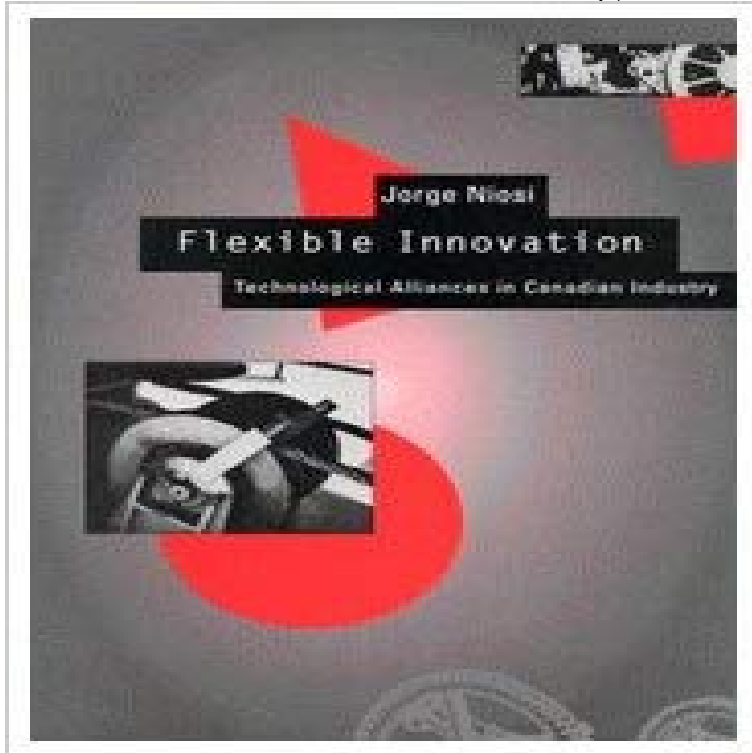


Flexible Innovation: Technological Alliances in Canadian Industry
