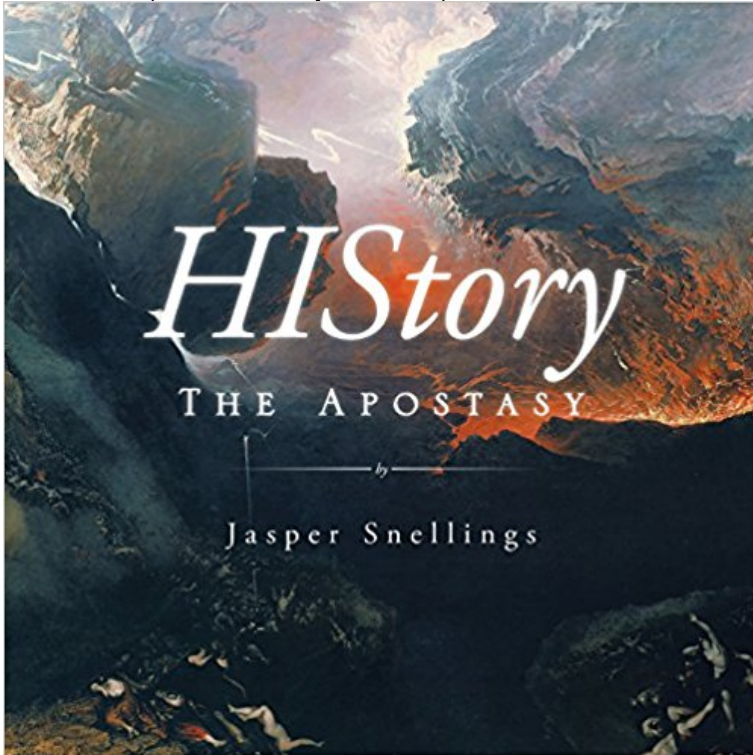


HIStory: The Apostasy
