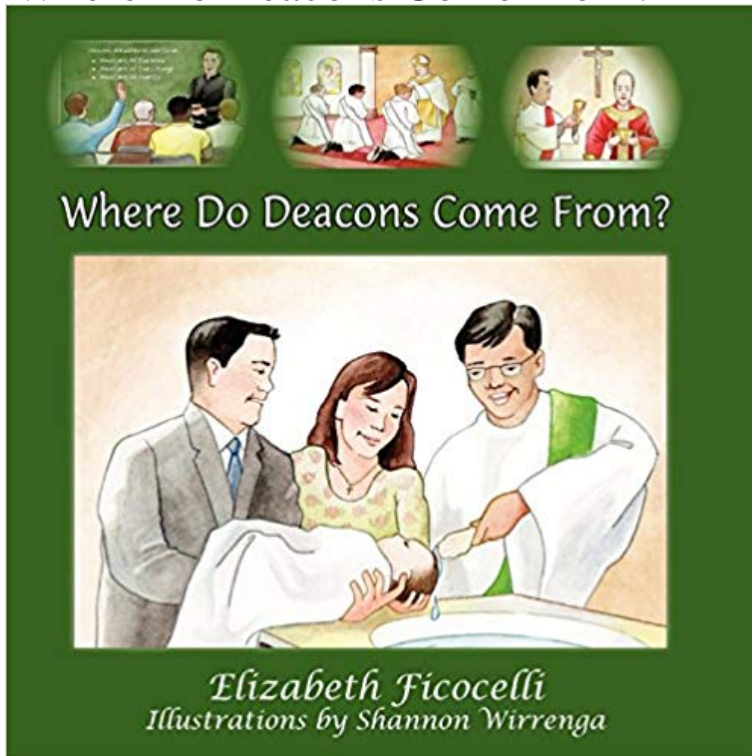


Where Do Deacons Come From?
