

Eliminating women in the professions and in domestic service, we have left for industrial pursuits only about half of the total in both cases, not a great number, it is true, but relatively very important. It must be remembered that the entire population of the two states is less than the total number of women workers in the whole country. The states with new industrial interests should profit by the experiences of older sections, and avoid certain unfortunate conditions that have proved disastrous to the workers and to society as a whole.
