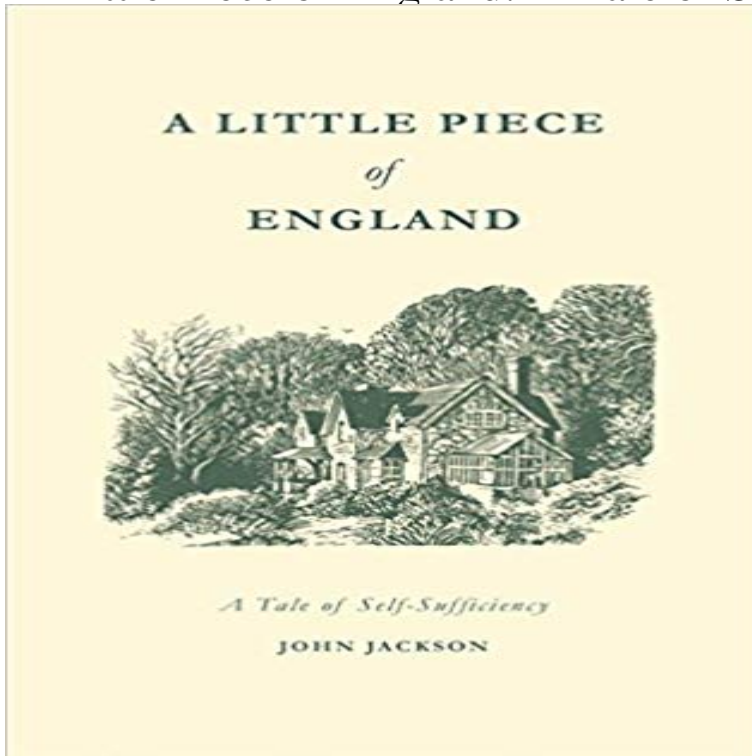


A Little Piece of England: A Tale of Self-Sufficiency
