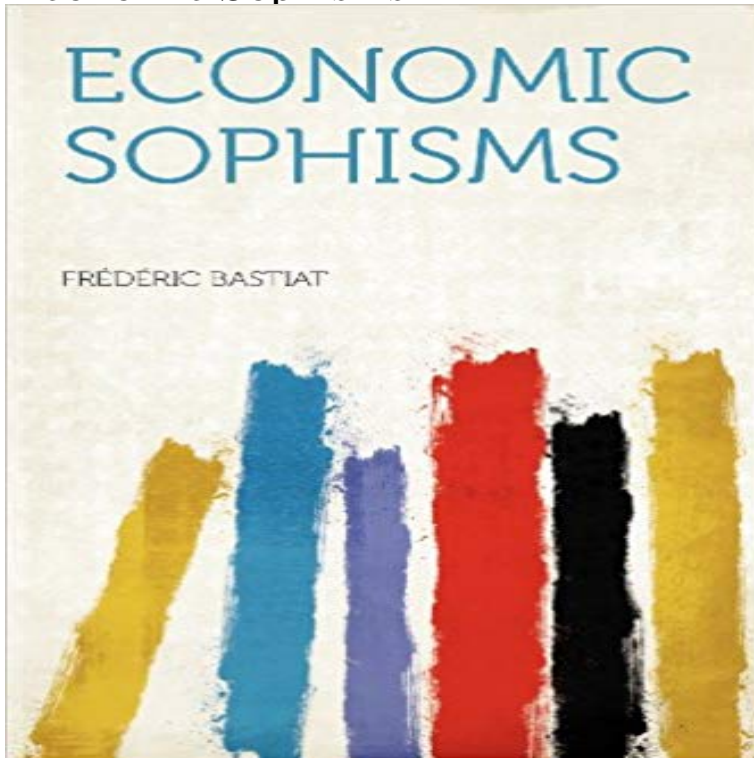


Economic Sophisms
