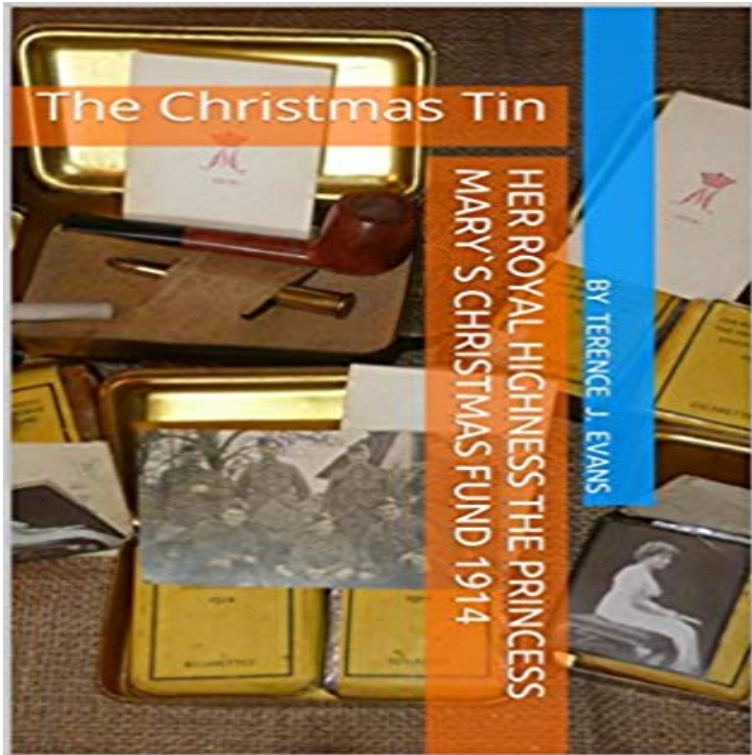


# Her Royal Highness The Princess Mary's Christmas Fund 1914: The Christmas Tin
