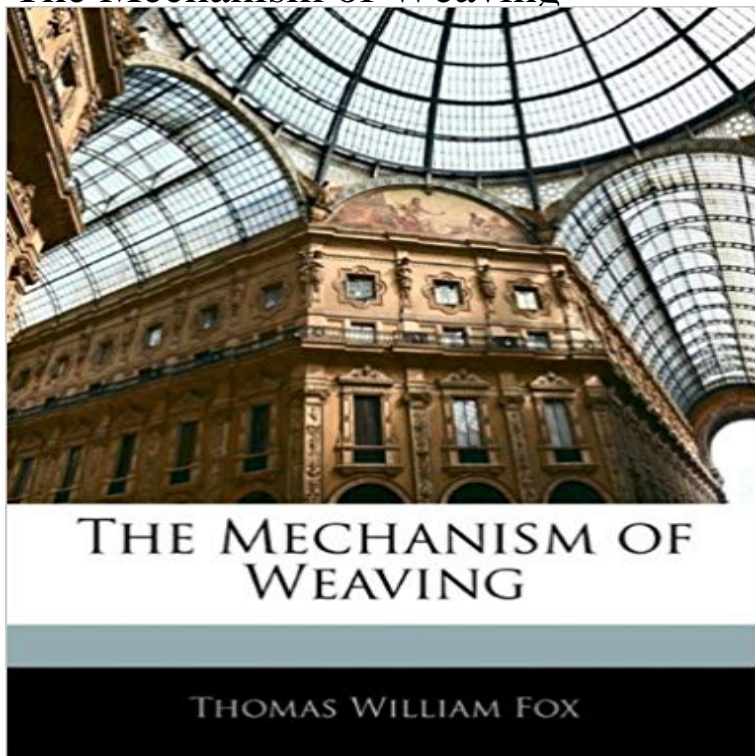


The Mechanism of Weaving
