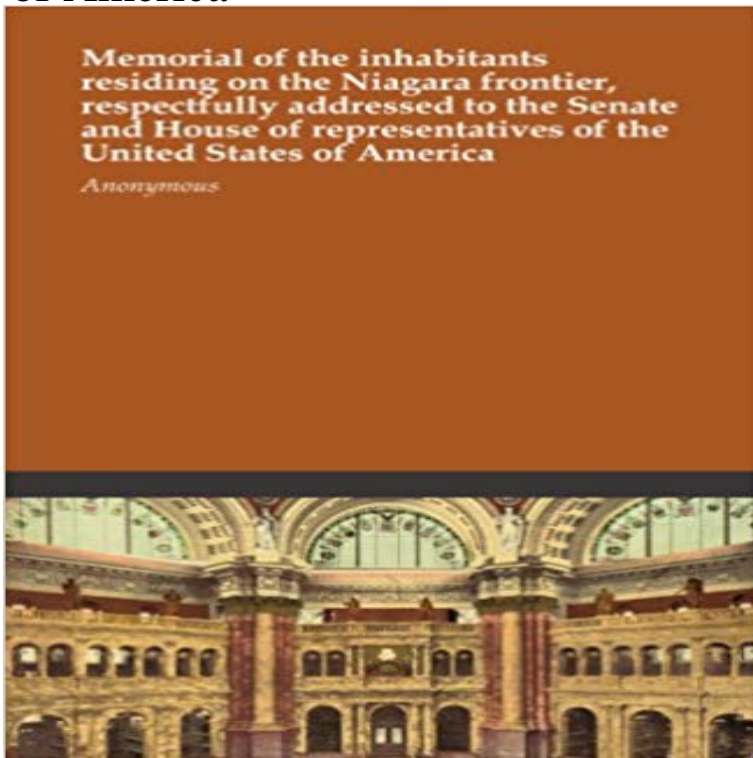


Memorial of the inhabitants residing on the Niagara frontier, respectfully addressed to the Senate and House of representatives of the United States of America
