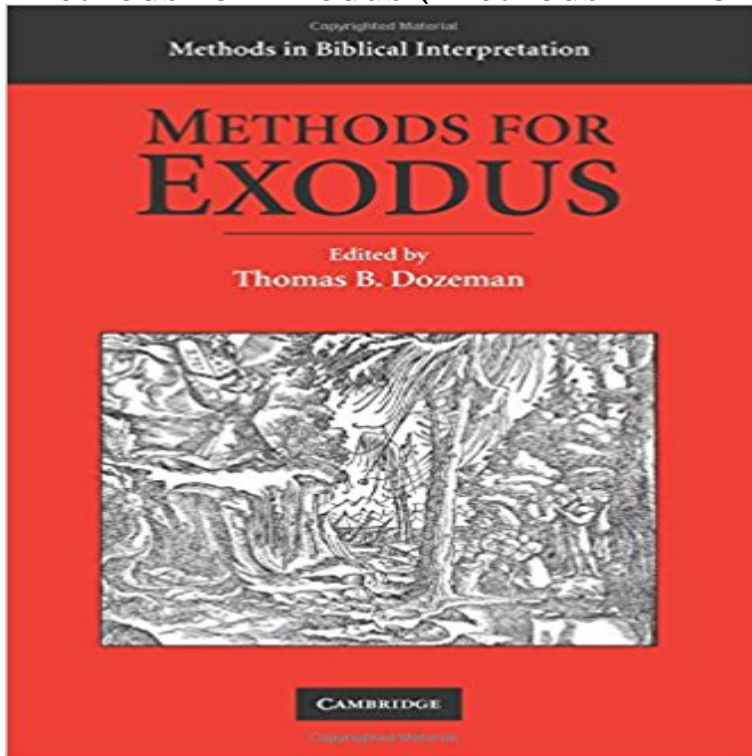


Methods for Exodus (Methods in Biblical Interpretation)
