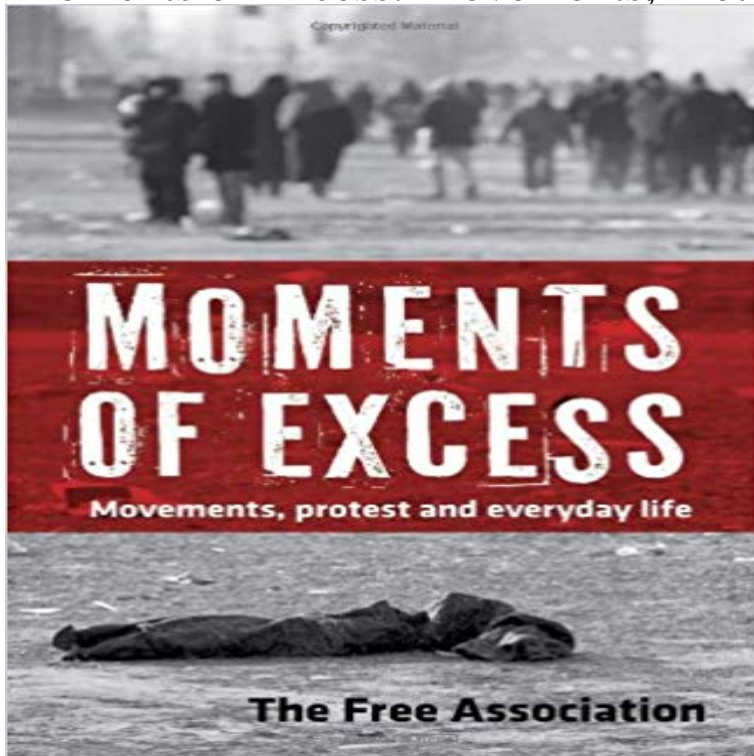


Moments of Excess: Movements, Protest and Everyday Life
