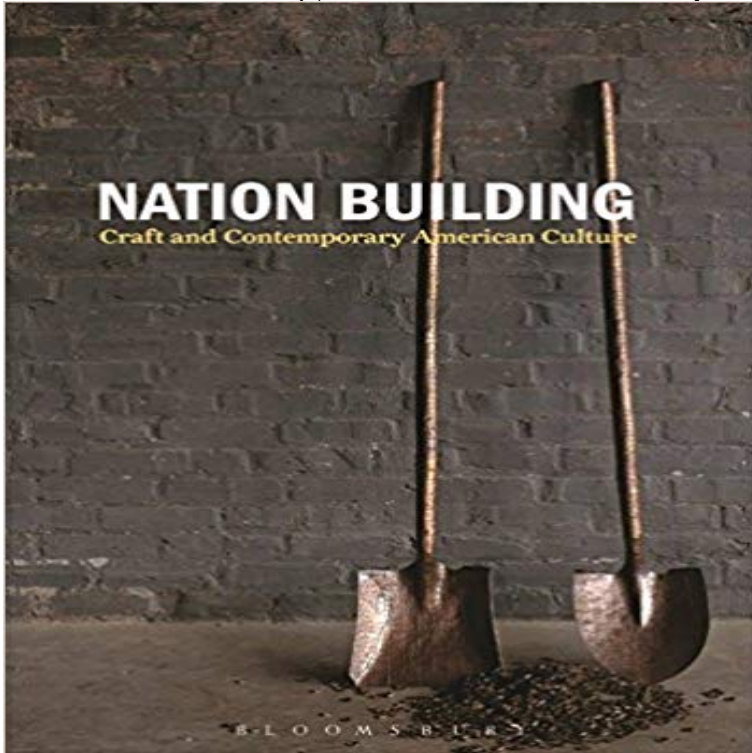


# Nation Building: Craft and Contemporary American Culture
