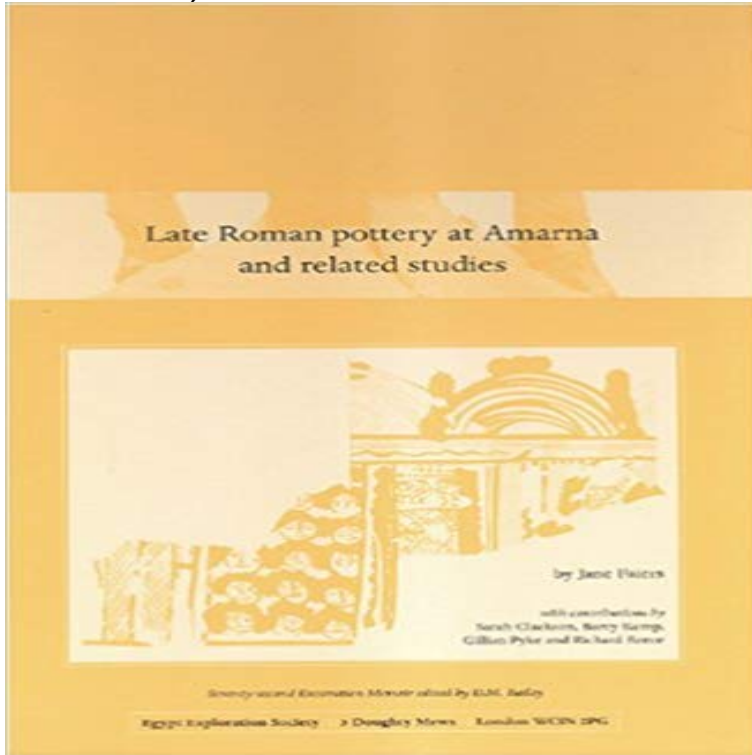


Late Roman Pottery at Amarna and Related Studies (Excavation Memoirs)

It is all of Late Roman date, and most was retrieved from rubbish pits. The site of Kom el-Nana itself has been identified as a monastery, a fact which affects the way the pottery - and all other finds - must be interpreted.
