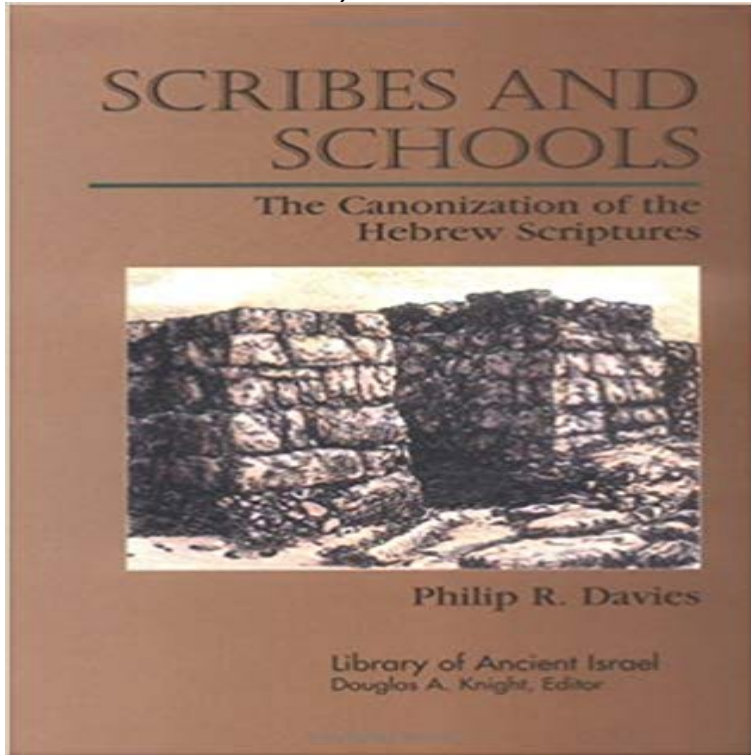


Scribes and Schools: The Canonization of the Hebrew Scriptures (Library of Ancient Israel)
