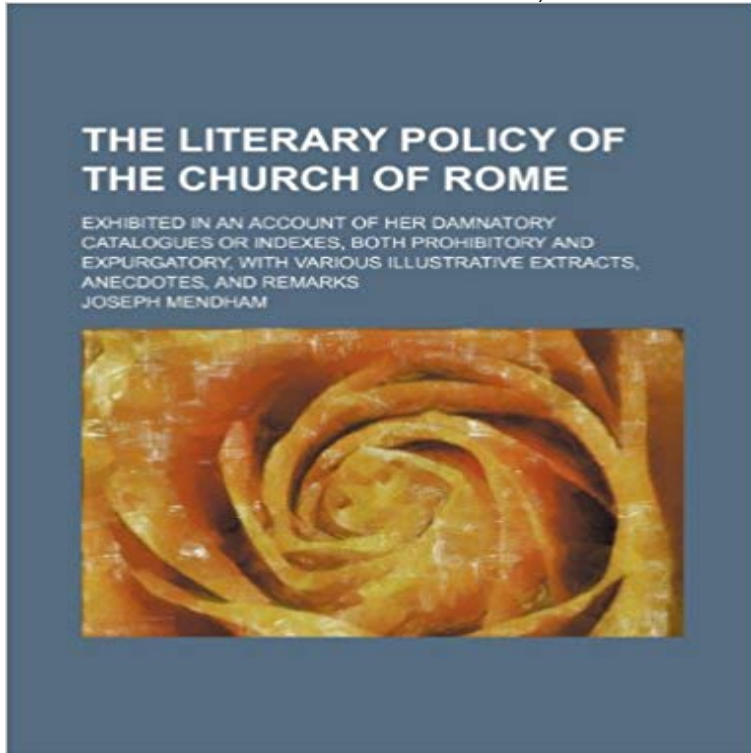

Bened.; and the tracts are peculiarly valuable, as containing two exculpatory letters by the then Bishop of Meaux himself, together with English versions of both. The work, whose fate and character I propose to explain, was written for the personal benefit of Marshal Turenne; and some MS. copies were taken about the year 1667. Four years after, in the early part of the year, the first printed edition made its transitory appearance. It was suppressed, and not intended to be known; and, for that purpose, was replaced at the end of the same year by what was avowed to be the first printed edition. The reason of this attempt was, the alleged and unconfuted allegation of a censure by the Doctors of the Sorbonne, and the necessity of alterations, which could not in prudence be allowed to appear. But, fortunately, the attempt did not succeed. Dr. Wake obtained a copy of the suppressed edition, imperfect indeed, but supplied in the defective portions, which were not considerable, by a manuscript transcript from a perfect copy in the possession of the family of Turenne.
