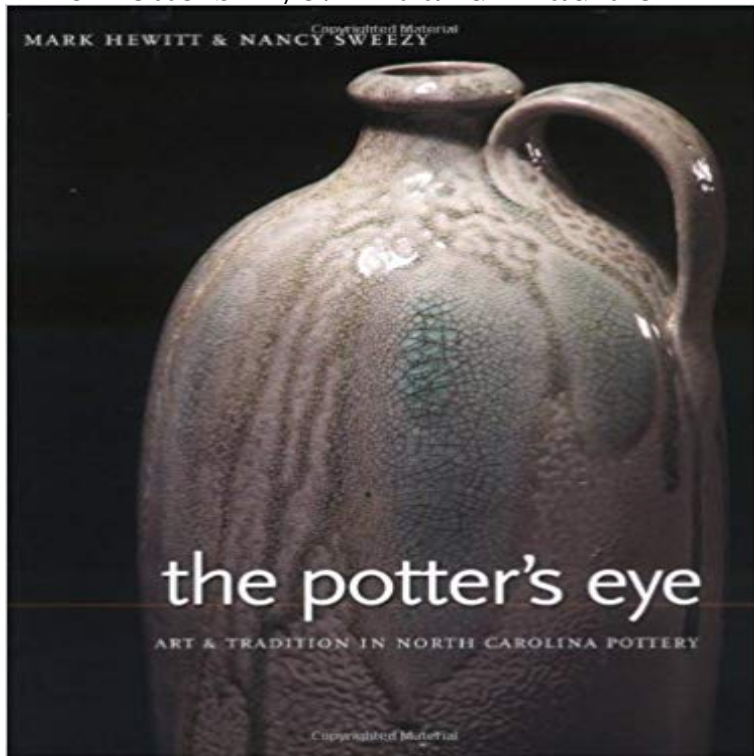


## The Potters Eye: Art and Tradition in North Carolina Pottery
