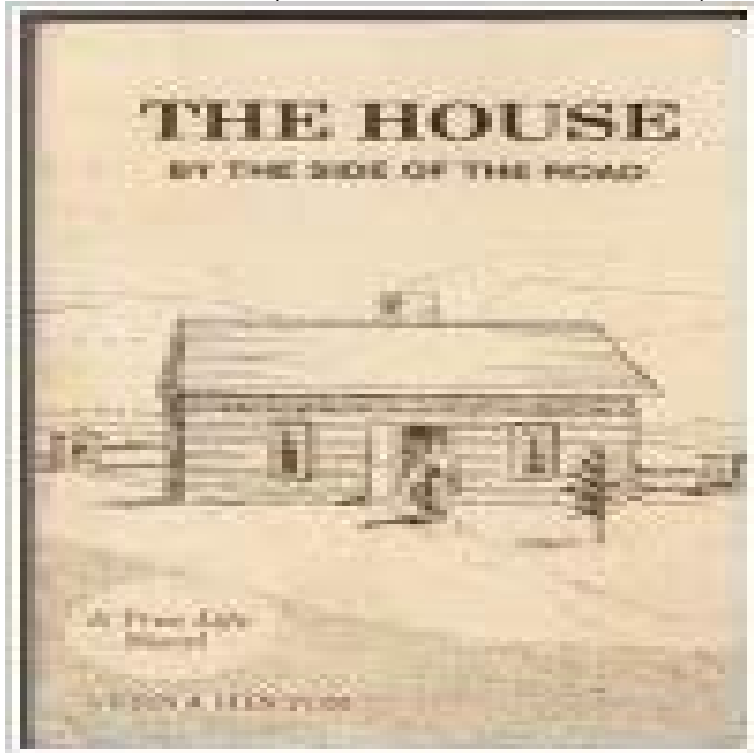


The House By the Side of the Road, a True Life Novel
